God created Adam and Eve and blessed them right away to bear many descendants etc. but the Bible tells us that their first child is Cain who is bornt only after Adam and Eve fell and were sent out of the garden so does that means Adam and Eve never produce an offspring before because they might not be tempted in a week or two when they are made. And Cain killed his brother and God deal with him and out of nowhere, he moved out towards the east and lived in Nod and having a wife, who are those people, are they his siblings?

Genesis 4:1 states: "Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived" Cain and Abel. It is not known if the boys were twins.

Troy Lacey wrote:

Eve could have been, and likely was, a mother by the time she was a one-year-old, and Adam could have been taking Cain on walks as a "two-year-old" man.

All people of the earth are descended from Adam and Eve.

Lancey continues:

Genesis 5:4 gives us a recap of Adam's life and mentions that he (and Eve) had "sons and daughters." We know for certain that at least one daughter had to have been born long before the sacrifice mentioned in Genesis 4¹, because Cain took his wife with him to Nod and there had children. But there may also have been other daughters and sons born to Adam by this time. In fact, Cain's statement in Genesis 4:14 (in light of Genesis 3:20²) only makes sense if there were several siblings by this time.³

Adam and Eve were *created* whereas all other men were *born* in sin (Ro 5:12) and in need of salvation (Jn 3:16).
