Do we have to believe that God rose Jesus from the dead to be saved? I know we have to believe in the resurrection, but if someone believes He rose from the dead but didn't know that God did it, is he not saved?

To be saved one must believe that: Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures (1 Co 15:3-4).

The resurrection was accomplished by: God, the Father (Ac 2:24); God, the Son (Jn 10:18); and God, the Holy Spirit (Ro 8:11).

David wrote of the future work of Christ (Ps 16:8–11) that the Lord Jesus would: rely on his father (v. 8), be resurrected by him (v. 9–10) and reign with him (v. 11).

Peter (Ac 2:25–31) and Paul (13:35–37) quoted or referred to Old Testament passages (Ps 16:8–11; 12; Is 53) which spoke of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

With one's heart—his whole being he believes (Ro 10:9). Jesus must be his Lord.

With God's power one can overcome sin and obtain new life (Ro 5:6; 8:3; Jn 1:12; 1 Co 1:18, 23–25; 2:1–4; 4:20; 1 Pe 1:23).
