Who was Georg Conrad Beissel? What was the Ephrata community?

Georg Conrad Beissel founded the Ephrata Cloister in Lancaster, Pennsylvania.¹ The Ephrata Society, an occult group in the 1700s, taught: celibacy, Sabbath keeping² and baptism for the dead³.

Christians should be sexually moral (Ac 15:20; 1 Thess 4:3) but celibacy (forbidding marriage) is unbiblical (1 Co 9:5, 1 Ti 3:2-4, 4:1-4, Tt 1:5-7).

We do not have a Sabbath *day*--we have a Sabbath *Lord* (Lk 6:5).

It is unscriptural to teach that baptism is indispensable for justification (1 Co 1:17).
