

*Is it okay to be happy for somebody who is LGBTQ?*

Open rebuke is better than love carefully concealed (Pr 27:5). Love tells the truth (Pr 28:23; Ps 141:5; Gal 4:16).

God made an example of Sodom and Gomorrah for men who would choose to live wickedly (2 Pe 2:6). Homosexuality is: forbidden (Lev 18:22), unclean (Ro 1:24, 26, 27) and considered an abomination (1 Kin 14:24). The punishment for homosexuality is death (Lev 20:13).

The Lord can free one from his sin (1 Jn 3:5). The Sodomite can be cleansed (1 Jn 1:7, 9) and washed in Christ's own blood (Re 1:5).

The Christian is not to participate in another's sin; rather he should keep himself pure (1 Ti 5:22).

The homosexual lifestyle leads to death (Jn 10:10, 1 Co 6:9-10). When one cares about another, he doesn't tolerate him—like one tolerates a bad smell; rather, he speaks. Adrian Rogers said, "It is better to tell the truth that hurts and heals than to tell a lie that comforts and then kills." Pr 27:6, Eccl 7:5.
