## Why is Hollywood so anti-Christian?

Hollywood exhibits an anti-Christian bias in its content and culture. They routinely portray Christians negatively in films and television, presenting them as "close-minded idiots"[1]. David Limbaugh's book argues that Hollywood and media routinely disparage Christians and present them in an unfavorable light[2]. Hollywood's values often conflict with Christian teachings, particularly regarding moral choices[3][4]. They are more interested in a "Christianity lite" which blends with wider culture without explicit religious references, potentially to appeal to a broader audience[5].

The apostle Paul encouraged the believer to focus on "whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable—if there is any moral excellence and if there is any praise—dwell on these things (Php 4:8, HCSB)." What one dwells on shapes his thoughts.

And the Lord Jesus said, "A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks (Lk 6:45)." The "treasure" or quality of one's heart will be revealed in his words and actions.

Cultivating one's heart and mind with positive and righteous thoughts will likely produce positive, righteous actions. Conversely, if one dwells on negative, sinful thoughts, he will likely produce negative, sinful actions.
