

*[Follow up question] ...So if I repent of arrogance, what about my bad attitude? Will God grant me mercy while I deal with sin?*

Yes, when the believer confesses his sin, God is faithful and just to forgive him of sin and to cleanse him from all unrighteousness (1 Jn 1:9).

Sin lies at the door. One should not submit to sin; rather, he should rule over it (Ge 4:7). Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you (Jas 4:7).

The Spirit of the Lord is able to free one from: bondage, doubt, wrong attitudes etc. (Ro 6:18, 22).

God will not allow the Christian to be tempted beyond what he is able; but, with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that he may be able to bear it (1 Co 10:13).

The child of God can cast his care on the Lord because he cares for him (1 Pe 5:7).

Receive his love (Jn 14:21), abide (Ps 91:1) and rest in him (Ps 37:7).
