Is America discussed in end times prophecy in the Bible?

There is no clear consensus on whether America is specifically mentioned in end times prophecy in the Bible. Several scholars and authors have explored this topic, but their conclusions vary. Some argue that America is not explicitly mentioned in biblical prophecy[1][2], while others suggest that the U.S. might be alluded to indirectly[3]. The Bible does not specifically discuss America's role in the end times[4]. Various interpretations have been proposed, including America being represented symbolically as "Tarshish and all her villages" or the "great eagle" in Revelation, but these are not universally accepted[2]. The Bible's focus in end-times prophecy appears to be primarily on Israel and nations directly related to it[1][2]. Some scholars suggest that America's absence from explicit mention could be due to it not playing a significant role in end times events, no longer existing by that time, or being included among other nations that reject God[1]. There is ongoing debate and speculation about America's place in biblical end times prophecy[2][3].
