I am considering Jainism. They don't harm animals.

Jainism arose in the sixth century BC in protest against the ritualism of Hinduism. Jains abstain from wrong thoughts and deeds in an attempt to escape the soul.<sup>1</sup>

All regions of the world are work-based (Jas 1:26); whereas Christianity is faith-based (Ro 3:26, 27).

Although it is thoughtful to be kind to living beings (Pr 12:10), it won't get one saved (Ps 14:1, Pr 28:26, Ga 2:16). Animals provided food for men after the flood (Ge 9:2-3, Mt 3:4).

God has revealed his existence to each person (Ro 1:20–32); but men push him away (Ro 1:18–19) and do not think of him (Ps 10:4).

The soul goes on after death (Mt 10:28); so one would be wise to seek a right relationships with his creator.

The prophet Isiah wrote:

Seek the Lord while He may be found,

Call upon Him while He is near.

Let the wicked forsake his way,

And the unrighteous man his thoughts;

Let him return to the Lord,

And He will have mercy on him. Is 55:6-7
