

*Could you give me some insight into why "worlds last chance" website is unbiblical? I have a friend that's been a Christian for 40 years—even started 200 home churches in Cambodia. He has fallen hook, line and sinker for this doctrine.*

The World's Last Chance cult, an offshoot of Seventh Day Adventists, concern themselves with the Sabbath day.

In the Book of Acts we read, "The disciples were meeting together for teaching and fellowship, on the first day of the week (Ac 20:7)."

We don't have a Sabbath *day*; rather, we have a Sabbath *Lord* (Luke 6:5). The believer struggles to rest in him (Ro 16:2, 3, 6, 12, Phil 1:27, 4:3). Christians do not judge others in matters of days (Ro 14:5–6a). Children of God should instead love one another (vv. 7–8).

The apostle Paul said, "One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind (v. 5)."

The World's Last Chance cult need not debate Saturday vs. Sunday worship (2 Ti 2:23, Tt 3:9).
