How do you know the difference between the devil trying to slow you down from pursuing Gods plan and God closing doors to guide you in the right direction?

God's word provides guidance for the believer. God's way is the best way (Eccl 10:2, Jn 10:10). When one first loves God and seeks to honor him (Mt 22:37–38) and loves his neighbor (v. 39) and does not defraud him (Mk 10:29), he will be in God's will (Ro 2:18).

The Spirit moves (Ge 1:2) and guides one through life (Ps 119:105) from glory to glory (2 Co 3:18) when he is in Christ (Eph 2:10).

Satan may try to put obstacles in the Christian's path—especially if he is effective for the Lord (Ez 4:1–5, 3 Jn 9, 10).

When God's children serve him in secret not trying to impress others, they will be rewarded (Mt 6:4).

Do all things to the glory of God (1 Co 10:31) ensuring that your gifts are acceptable to him (Jas 1:27, Jud 11).

Other believers can encourage you (He 10:24) to continue on (Phil 3:14). Pray for direction (Ex 33:13) and ask the Lord to teach you which way to go (Ps 143:8).
