I saw that the devil can transform himself as an angel of light and that the sons of God (which are understood to be fallen angels) in genesis 6 materialized into flesh bodies. Could a fallen angel appear to us in a human body? Can they materialize as people fooling us? How much power does Satan have?

Demons can possess humans beings (Mt 8:28, 29). They can instigate evil (1 Ti 4:1) and they are able to overcome men (Ac 19:13–16).

There are many (Mk 5:8, 9) unclean (Mt 10:1), powerful (Lk 8:29), evil (vv. 10:17, 18) demons in the world who work for Satan (Mt 12:24–30). They recognize Christ (Mk 1:23, 24).

One day the devil will go into the Lake of Fire (Re 20:10). Until that time Christians should put on the full armor of the Lord to stand against the wiles of the devil (Eph 6:11). We are not unaware of his schemes (2 Co 2:11).

Christians have the authority to drive out demons (Mk 3:15).

Satan is capable of masquerading as an angels of light (e.g. a lost loved one) [2 Co 11:14]. Satan can transform his followers in a similar fashion (v. 15).

The Christian should test all things so as not to be deceived (1 Thess 5:21).

In the end times Nephilim (Ge 6:4, Nu 13:33, 2 Sa 21:16-22) may reappear (Lk 17:26).

In the strong delusion to come, demons may attempt to appear as aliens from another world (2 Thess 2:11).

It is important to be rooted and grounded in the word of God (2 Ti 2:15).
