Can New Age religion be practiced without even knowing you are practicing it?

The New Age god is impersonal. He is called: a force, an energy or an all-pervading reality.

New Agers believe in an evolutionary godhood (i.e. God is everything and we are all becoming God) and in global unity (i.e. bringing everything together).

New Age code words include: new consciousness, new orientalism, cosmic humanism, cosmic consciousness, mystical humanism, human potential movement and holistic health movement.

New Age buzzwords include: awakening, enlightenment, centering, channeling consciousness, cosmic energy, force of life, global village, holistic, human potential, self-actualization, networking, planetary vision, space ship earth, synergistic, transcendental, transformational and transpersonal.

Symbols used by New Agers include: rainbow, pyramid, triangle, eye in a triangle, Pegasus, concentric circles, rays of light, swastika, ying yang, goat head on a pentagram, the number 666, the unicorn.

New Age practices include: astral projection, channeling spirits and crystal usage. They speak a "Christ principle" or of having a "Christ consciousness."

New Age religion teaches that man is essentially good and that he can create his own reality.

The Bible says God is personal—He has all attributes of personhood (Phil 3:10).

According to scripture man is fallen in Adam (Gen. 3:1–5, Ro 3:12) and in need of a savior (Ac 17:27).

Anyone practicing New Age religion knowingly or unknowingly (Ps 19:12, 2 Pe 2:1) should repent before God (Acts 2:37, 38).
