Was Adam bi-sexual before Eve was made? I heard this come from another bible teacher that I respect; but, it did not sit right with me.

Adam and Eve were created "very good" (Ge 1:31) not perverted (Ge 1:27) in any way. When Adam and Eve sinned (Ge 3:24), all that was good became bad (2 Co 11:3).

False teachers (2 Pe 2:1) who promote sexual sin¹ should not be respected; but rather, they should be exposed (Eph 5:11). The bible says that the soul who sins shall die (Eze 18:4).

The apostle Paul wrote:

Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. 1 Co 6:9–10

Marriage is: one man, one woman (Ge 2:18–24) in covenant (Mt 19:6) for life (Ro 7:2, 3). God's character has not changed (Mal 3:6). His committed to righteousness (Is 11:4). Thankfully, he is also committed to getting each and every person saved (Jn 3:16). He will do all he can to save each person (Is 11:4, Ac 17:27).

When men avail themselves of this opportunity, God cleans them up (1 Jn 1:7). No one should believe that he is getting away with sexual sin (Ga 6:7).² One should flee from sin (1 Co 6:18) or he risks dying (Re 21:8) a second death (Re 20:14).

Unfortunately, many cultures promote infidelity (Jer 16:2). The rare soul (Mt 7:13-14) who will rejects his deprayed culture can live with God in heaven forever (Re 21:27).

Adam and Eve named the animals (Ge 2:19, 20). God took Eve from Adam's side (Ge 2:18–22) to be his helper (Ge 2:20).

Though art often depicts Adam as effeminate; he was in fact made perfectly (Ge 1:31, 9:6). God made them (Ge 5:2)³ male and female (Mt 19:4).
