

*What am I supposed to do when atheists say they found the truth in atheism?*

Jesus said that he is the way the truth and the life and that no one comes to the Father except through him (Jn 14:6). Since he is the only person who died and rose again, one would do well to listen to what he has to say about the afterlife (Re 1:18).

If your atheist friend is right, then he's got nothing to lose (1 Co 15:19). But if he's wrong, he has everything to lose--including his eternal soul (Mt 8:12).

Someone said, "It ain't what you don't know that gets you into trouble. It's what you know for sure that just ain't so." When he gets to know the true and living God (Ro 1), perhaps he will come to love him (Ac 26:28).
