What do you know about the hollow earth theory?

Hollow Earth theorists believe that the earth has another world beneath our own. The earth has an: inner core (to 1300 kilometers), outer core (to 2250 kilometers), mantle (to 2900 kilometers) and crust (8 to 40 kilometers). There is a demonic world; but, it is not visible to humans (Jn 4:24).

When the apostle John wrote of an underworld from which demons will come forth in the future, he used symbolic language.

Regarding Revelation 9:1-3¹ John MacArthur wrote:

9:1-2 bottomless pit. Lit. "pit of the abyss." Mentioned 7 times in Revelation, it always refers to the prison where some of the demonic hordes are incarcerated, the place of severest torment and isolation (vv. 1, 2, 11; 11:7; 17:8; 20:1, 3; see notes on Luke 8:31; 2 Pet. 2:4; Jude 6, 7).

9:3 locusts. A grasshopper-like insect that descends in swarms so thick they can obscure the sun and strip bare all vegetation. In the 1950s a locust swarm devoured every growing thing for several hundred thousand square miles in the Middle East. These are not normal locusts, however, but specially prepared ones that are merely the outward form of demons, who, like locusts, will bring swarming desolation (see notes on Joel 2:1–5). "Like" appears 9 times in John's description; he finds it difficult to describe what he sees in a way the reader can understand...²

Luciferins believe that CERN, a hadron collider, can open portals to demonic realms. Demons will be released in the future (Re 9:1).

The earth (2 Pet. 3:7–12) and natural heavens (Heb. 1:10–12; 2 Pet. 3:10) will be destroyed and made all new (Is. 65:17, 2 Pe 3:13).

What I heard about it was that what they found in the hollow earth was a beautiful paradise-like place.

People do not live under the earth.³ The world was made "very good" (Ge 1:31); but, after the fall of man (Ge 3:1–5) the earth became very bad (Ge 3:17). Adam was driven from paradise (Ge 3:24). The earth was made disposable by sin (Ro 8:20–23).

There is no evidence for alien life inside the earth or in outer space; though, there is a strong delusion to come (2 Thess 2:9, 11). The apostle Paul warned, "If he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted—you may well put up with it!" 2 Corinthians 11:4, NKJV.

³ There was a time when men who rejected the Lord were spiritually destroyed (e.g. Korah's followers who were swallowed by the earth [Num. 16:28–35]). They did not live. They died (Heb. 9:27).

If there were aliens, they could not be saved because the Lord died for all men *in Adam* (Ro 5:19).⁴ Should one set himself up as a god (Re 13:15)⁵, there are many (Gal. 2:3-4) who would worship him (Matt. 15:8-9). Men who will not believe the truth (Lk 18:8) will believe a lie (2 Thess 2:11).

Paradise lost will be paradise restored—not in a fake millennium; rather, when the Lord Jesus returns to rule and reign (Re 20:1–10).

Deceivers will claim that there is peace and safety when sudden destruction comes upon (1 Thess 5:3) those who will not humble themselves before the Lord (Lk 21:36).
