

*What does the Bible say about laughing at other people's misfortunes?*

The Bible says: Do not be happy when your enemy falls, and do not feel glad when he stumbles (Pr 24:17, GWT). God may be displeased and start to prosper him (v. 18).

An enemy's heart may be softened by acts of kindness (Pr 25:21).

The Christian can maintain trust (He 10:38) in God's: goodness (Ps 31:19), righteousness (Is 11:4) and justice (Deut 32:4). No one is getting by with their sin (Ro 6:23). God will make all things right (Ge 18:25).

If one is truly your enemy (Ga 4:16), you can give him the gospel (1 Pe 1:12). We would not wish for anyone to go to hell (2 Pe 3:9, Re 21:8).
