

*Where do people get the idea that fainting is something holy?*

Daniel fainted after God revealed his program for Israel and for the gentiles (Dan 8:27). Men aren't typically given this insight into history future today.

We are to test false professors (Gal 2:3-4) who pretend to be true (Mt 7:22, 23). Many (Mt 24:3, 11) teach lies (Jer 28:15) and corruption (2 Pe 2:10-22).

The Holy Spirit (not false spirits) indwells every believer (Ro 8:9-11). It is his ministry to convict men of sin (John 16:8-11). He sanctifies men (Ro 15:16; 2 Thess 2:13) and gives them discernment (1 Co 2:10-16; 1 Jn 4:1-6).

*Did Jesus ever cause people to faint or laid his hands on people and they fell to the ground?*

When Levites were set apart for service, the leaders of Israel laid hands on them (Nu 8:10, 11). Men cannot share the Holy Spirit (2 Ti 2:15). Each must receive the Spirit for himself (Ac 2:38).
