Where do people get the idea that fainting is something holy?

Daniel fainted after God revealed his program for Israel and for the gentiles (Dan 8:27). Men aren't typically given this insight into history future today.

We are to test false professors (Gal 2:3-4) who pretend to be true (Mt 7:22, 23). Many (Mt 24:3, 11) teach lies (Jer 28:15) and corruption (2 Pe 2:10–22).

The Holy Spirit (not false spirits) indwells every believer (Ro 8:9–11). It is his ministry to convict men of sin (John 16:8–11). He sanctifies men (Ro 15:16; 2 Thess 2:13) and gives them discernment (1 Co 2:10–16; 1 Jn 4:1–6).

Did Jesus ever cause people to faint or laid his hands on people and they fell to the ground?

When Levites were set apart for service, the leaders of Israel laid hands on them (Nu 8:10, 11). Men cannot share the Holy Spirit (2 Ti 2:15). Each must receive the Spirit for himself (Ac 2:38).
