Why would our creator give us the power to get wealth but not the power to meet all our human needs?

If one's needs were met on earth, he would not want to be in heaven with God (Ro 8:22, Phil 1:23,). The bride longs for her bridegroom (So 2:9).

Oswald Chambers said, "There is only one being who can satisfy the last aching abyss of the human heart, and that is the Lord Jesus Christ."

The believer has present grief (Ro 8:18a, 23) but future glory (8:18b, 24–25). He must endure with patience (Ro 8:25, Re 14:12).

Christians are blessed (Tt 2:13). They have partial enlightenment now (1 Co 13:9–12) and one day they will have complete enlightenment (Is 60:19).

The believer hopes in God (Ps 42:5, 11). He can cast his cares on him (1 Pe 5:7).
