Will the inhabitants of Iran or Elam be scattered in a humanitarian crisis?

There is a prophecy in Jeremiah 49:34-39 that describes a future scenario where the inhabitants of Elam (modern-day Iran) will be scattered. The prophecy states that the people of Elam will be "completely dispersed all over the world"[1][2]. This dispersion is described as being caused by "four winds from the four corners of heaven"[3]. The scattering is predicted to be extensive, with the text stating "there will be no nation to which the outcasts of Elam will not go"[3]. This dispersion is described as temporary, with the prophecy indicating that eventually, the inhabitants will return and resettle Iran[1][2]. There may be a humanitarian crisis which causes the destruction and the scattering of people[1][2][3].
