When 7 siblings inherit a house from parents, is it God's will for 1 sibling to keep it from the other 6?

God's decision in Numbers chapter 27 verses 1-11¹ became the basis for Israel's inheritance laws.

There was legal protection for the rights of one's firstborn.² A father was a give a double portion of all that he had to his son: "for he is the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn is his (Dt 21:17)."

God protected his people. His children love and protect one another in kind (Ps 133:1, 1 Jn 3:14).
