When I notice my loved ones sinning, I get really sad. Am I too sensitive?

The consequences of sin among the unregenerate include: blindness (Jn 9:41; 2 Co 4:3, 4), servitude (Jn 8:34), irreconcilable differences (2 Ti 3:1–7) and death (Ro 6:23, Re 21:8).

One should not be a busybody (1 Pe 4:15); but when a loving confrontation is necessary (Mt 5:13, 2 Co 4:7, Jud 1:23), then love (1 Jn 4:16-17) tells the truth (Ac 9:26–29).

Indifference or apathy is hatred (Mt 24:12, Lk 17:26–30, Re 3:15, 16).

A healthy functioning conscience remains sensitive to sin (Ro 13:4, 5).
