

What are Satan's strengths and weaknesses?

Satan is described as: cunning (Ge 3:1; 2 Co 11:3), slanderous (Jb 1:9), fierce (Lk 8:29), deceitful (2 Co 11:14), powerful (Eph 2:2), proud (1 Ti 3:6), cowardly (Jas 4:7) and wicked (1 Jn 2:13).¹

His greatest weakness is that he is a God's adversary (1 Pe 5:8). He has been judged (Jn 16:11). He will be: crushed (Ro 16:20), cast out (Jn 12:31) and assigned to hell (Mt 25:41).²

Humans can be saved; whereas fallen angels cannot (Ge 3:15, Is 59:16, 17, Mt 1:21, Lk 1:69, 77). This is good for men (Ro 13:11); but, bad for Satan (Re 20:10) and his followers (Mt 25:41, 2 Pe 2:4, Re 21:8).
