What happens to a person if they do believe in God but go to cult like churches Mormons or Jehovah's Witnesses? Do they go to heaven, too?

No. There is one way, one truth and one life in the person of Jesus Christ (Jn 14:6). The Lord asked, "Who do men say I am?" Mk 8:27. The answer to that question decides one's eternal destiny (1 Jn 5:12). Men must believe that Jesus is who he said he is to be saved (Jn 8:24). One must place his trust in him to enter heaven (Jn 10:1).

Jehovah's Witnesses call Jesus the archangel Michael. Mormons say he is the spirit brother of Lucifer (2 Pe 2:1); but, no cult or 'ism will ever get by Jn 1:1-3.

The apostle John said:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. Jn 1:1-3

God has done all he can to save men. He requires a response from each individual.

The apostle Paul wrote:

- For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Ro 3:22–23).
- But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (v. 5:8).
- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord (v. 6:23).
- If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved (v. 10:9).
- For whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved (v. 10:13).

Only the Jesus of scripture saves. The bible says: Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation (2 Co 6:2).
